# **Library Committee Charge**

## Mission:

To make reading or audio-visual materials on Quaker-related subjects available for loan to Meeting members and attenders.

## **Term & Dates of Service:**

Starts July 1 and ends June 30; may be reappointed annually

#### **Selection Process:**

Nominated by the Nominating Committee and approved by the Monthly Meeting.

## **Prinicpal Job Duties:**

The Adult Lending Library

- 1. To lend books, pamphlets, magazines, and audio-visual materials belonging to the Meeting Library to members and attenders. To arrange for the timely return and re-shelving of borrowed materials.
- 2. To maintain the library collections in good order using whatever cataloging system they think most appropriate.
- 3. To acquire through purchase or donation new or replacement materials to meet ongoing needs of the Meeting and to keep the Meeting informed of them.
- 4. To undertake repair and preservation of older library materials that cannot be easily replaced.
- 5. To prepare an annual budget for the Library supplies and purchase of new materials including the Pendle Hill Pamphlet series and Friends Journal subscriptions.

## The Sale of Used or Donated Books and Pamphlets

- 1. To periodically sell or give away materials culled from the collection as well as used materials donated to the Library that are not currently needed or felt to be appropriate.
- 2. Income from these sales will go to the Library's Donations and Sales Fund.

## Membership:

4-6 members or attenders

## **Budget Considerations:**

The Clerk will submit a budget request to the Clerk of the Property and Finance Committee by the last day of September each year.
