# **Religious Education Committee Charge**

## Mission:

Oversees and manages the educational activities of the Meeting in order to foster community awareness and understanding of:

- 1. Quaker testimonies
- 2. Friends' spiritual practices
- 3. History of the Religious Society of Friends
- 4. Christian heritage upon which Quakerism was founded
- 5. Changing trends within Quakerism.

**Term & Dates of Service:** Starts July 1 and ends June 30; may be reappointed annually.

**Selection Process:** Nominated by the Nominating Committee and approved by the Monthly Meeting.

#### **Job Duties:**

- 1. Meets 4-5 times per year especially before the beginning of the fall (August), winter (November or December), and summer (April or May) terms to plan teaching assignments and curriculum.
- 2. Organizes and manages children's, youth, and adult religious education classes, as needed; but with an emphasis on First Day classes for children and youth.
- 3. Purchases and maintains supplies and equipment needed for First Day School.
- 4. Prepares an annual report of committee activities for Monthly Meeting.

## Membership:

Consists of at least 2-8 people who are Friends or attenders who are familiar with the beliefs and practices of Friends.

# **Coordination with Others:**

Coordinates as needed with other committees.

All members are encouraged to attend meetings of the Ohio Valley Yearly Meeting Religious Education Committee.

## **Budget Considerations:**

The Clerk will submit a budget request to the Clerk of the Property & Finance Committee by the last day of September each year.
